LEADING OFF

- » Milwaukee starts the month of April with four consecutive on the road beginning with Valparaiso on Tuesday before a three-game league series at Purdue Fort Wayne this weekend.
- » The Panthers went 3-1 last week with a non-conference win over UW-River Falls before taking the first two games of the series at Northern Kentucky in Highland Heights, 13-3 and 11-8.
- » Last week the Panthers outscored their opponents by a 39-22 margin.
- » Leading the way was Tyler Bickers, who had a 5-for-5 effort in the team's win over NKU on Saturday, the five hits in a game is the 23rd time a player had five in one game in MKE history.
- » Gavin Theis was Milwaukee's most effective starting pitcher on the week with 4 2/3 innings in the team's series opener at Northern Kentucky. Eamonn Mulhern made two appearances in relief and tossed 4 2/3 innings and allowed just one run while striking out three.
- » Valparaiso is 6-17 to start the season and dropped 2-of-3 to Evansville in league play. No stranger to the Beacons, Milwaukee is 41-33 in all-time Division I meetings against Valparaiso including last season's 7-3 win at Franklin Field on Apr. 9.
- » Purdue Fort Wayne swept the Oakland Golden Grizzlies at home this past weekend in a thre game series winning wins all three by one run (14-13, 3-2, 6-5) including walk-off winners in the first two games. PFW will host Central Michigan before welcoming the Panthers to Fort Wayne this weekend. Milwaukee is 17-13 in all-time meetings with Purdue Fort Wayne including a 5-2 record in 2024.

SHAUN **WEGNER**

HEAD COACH SECOND SEASON MILWAUKEE '10

Shaun Wegner was promoted to the role of Milwaukee baseball coach in the summer of 2023 after joining the staff in August of 2017 as an assistant and serving as associate head coach for four seasons. He enters his second season as head coach in 2025.

In his time as head coach, Wegner has led the Panthers to 19 victories with 13 of those coming in Horizon League play as the team earned the fourth seed in postseason play in 2024. He has overseen four student-athletes earn All-League honors including two First Team selections.

During his time as an assistant with Milwaukee, Wegner helped the program to 129 wins over five full seasons plus the COVID-19 shortened 2020 campaign, that span included runs to the championship round of the Horizon League Tournament in both 2019 and 2021. Through his tenure on the staff, 22 Panthers have earned All-Horizon League First or Second Team honors, while Tyler Bordner went on to add ABCA/Rawlings All-Mideast Regional accolades in 2019.

Wegner returned to Milwaukee after spending five seasons at Whitewater. The NCAA Division III powerhouse claimed Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference championships in four of his seasons on staff, compiling an impressive 184-53 overall win-loss record (.776 winning percentage), which included an 88-22 mark (.800) in league play.

Wegner worked as Whitewater's hitting coach, catching coach, recruiting coordinator, and camp coordinator during his tenure with the Warhawks. Included in that span was an appearance in the College World Series in 2015 and the NCAA Division III National Championship in 2014. Each of his seasons at Whitewater culminated with postseason appearances in the NCAA Tournament.

After graduating from Milwaukee in 2010, Wegner served as graduate assistant coach at Minnesota-Mankato for two years. He earned an award for the highest GPA in Minnesota State history. During Wegner's two seasons on staff, the Mavericks posted a combined record of 91-24 (.791 winning percentage) and qualified for the NCAA Division II Tournament twice, including a trip to the 2012 Division II College World Series, which yielded a third-place finish.

Wegner played at Milwaukee from 2006-10, capping his time with the Panthers by helping the team to the Horizon League Tournament Championship and NCAA Tournament his senior season. He batted .300 that campaign, scoring 26 runs and knocking in 29 more. Wegner was named Second Team All-Horizon League as a sophomore, batting .329 overall and .389 in league play. A team captain for two seasons, Wegner was named to the Horizon League All-Newcomer Team as a freshman and went on to lead the conference in runners thrown out and runners picked off each of his final three years. In 180 career games at UWM, he finished with a .286 average, 87 runs batted in, 101 runs scored and 162 hits.

Wegner also has coaching experience in the Northwoods League. He was an assistant with the Lakeshore Chinooks in 2012, the team's inaugural season. In addition to his summer with the Chinooks, Wegner served as the field manager and an administrator for the Sheboygan A's, who play in the Wisconsin State League, Northeastern Wisconsin League and the Langsdorf League of Southeastern Wisconsin.

Wegner graduated in 2010 with degrees in communications and economics from Milwaukee. He earned his master's degree in sports management in May 2012 from Minnesota-Mankato.

Wegner is a member of the American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA).

GAME NOTES

LOOKING AT VALPARAISO

Valparaiso will play its first home game of the season at Emory Bauer Field on Tuesday against the Panthers. The Beacons had served as the home team in late February at Curtis Granderson Stadium against Niagara for its two previous 'home' contests. The Beacons are 6-17 overall and are 2-4 in Missouri Valley play.

The Beacons were selected 10th out of 10 teams in the Missouri Valley this year under the direction of 12th year head coach Brian Schmack. This year's team enters the week ninth in the league in both batting average at .258, while the team has scored the fewest runs in the league with 132. The team is also last in the MVC in doubles with 37, total bases with 303, and stolen bases with just 10.

On the mound, Valpo is also ninth in the league in earned run average at 8.51 and has the ninth-most strikeouts with 158. The staff has allowed the fourth fewest walks over 183 innings pitched, allowing just 118. Milwaukee is expected to face Lucas Foley, who currently has a 11.88 ERA over his first six outings this season, including three starts. Foley had his best outing of the year his last time out allowing just one earned run over four innings with three strikeouts in long relief versus Indiana State.

The Panthers will face a lineup that features three hitters with better than .300 batting averages led by team leader Ryan Maka, who is hitting .356 with four home runs and 10 RBIs. Liam Patton has a .329 average and leads the team with 18 RBIS, while Kevin Denty has a team-best seven doubles with a .303 average. Case Sullivan lead the Beacons with 22 runs scored and has 13 RBIs, while Connor Giusti has driven in 15 runs but has a .183 average at the plate.

LOOKING AT PURDUE FORT WAYNE

A weekend filled of one-run wins over Oakland has put Purdue Fort Wayne right into the thick of the standings through the first three weekends of Horizon League play. The Mastodons are in a three-way tie for second place with Milwaukee and Northern Kentucky at 5-4 each, while Wright State paces the field of six teams with an 8-1 conference mark.

Doug Schreiber's squad is currently fifth in the league in batting with a .250 average, with only Milwaukee at .242 trailing the Mastodons. However, Purdue Fort Wayne has scored 25 fewer runs than the Panthers this season at a least-worst 132 through 26 games in 2025. PFW is tied for fifth in the league with 32 doubles and trail the league in home runs with just 15 on the season.

Meanwhile, Purdue Fort Wayne's pitching staff is fourth in the Horizon with an 8.82 ERA over 214 1/3 innings this year with a league-low 147 strikeouts as a staff. The Mastodon staff has been prone to the home run ball having allowed 35 this season, with Milwaukee's 45 home runs allowed last in the league. Expected to take the hill this weekend for PFW will be Dillon Fischer, Zane Danielson, and Gavin Walters. Fischer has a 9.08 ERA over 35 2/3 innings with 25 strikeouts, while Danielson has been most effective with a 3.92 ERA over a team-high 39 innings with 27 strikeouts. Walters has made just four starts in his six appearances and has tossed 14 2/3 innings to an 11.05 ERA.

Justin Osterhouse continues to be the primary focal point of the Mastodon offense, as he has a team-best .303 average and leads the team with six home runs ant 19 RBIs. Camden Karczewski is hitting .276 followed by Augusto Schroeder with a .268 mark and 14 RBIs. Jackson Micheels is second to Osterhouse in both home runs with four and RBIs with 17 this season but is only hitting .234 this season.

UP NEXT

After the weekend in Fort Wayne, Milwaukee returns home for an eight-game homestand beginning with non-conference lowa on Apr. 8 before welcoming the Oakland Golden Grizzlies to Franklin Field from Apr. 11-13. UIC and Youngstown State will round-out the eight-game stay at home.

FIVE-FOR-FIVE

In Milwaukee's win over Northern Kentucky on Mar. 29, Tyler Bickers was 5-for-5 in his at bats becoming the 23rd Panther in program history to have at least five hits in a game. This is the second-straight season that Milwaukee has had a five-hit performance by a student-athlete, making it back-to-back seasons since the 2012 and 2013 campaigns that a Panther has had five hits in a game i

HOME RUN PACE

With 32 combined home runs through the team's first 26 games, Milwaukee is currently on pace to finish the season with 71 home runs this year. The program mark for homers in a season is 77 set in 1999, while 71 would put this year's team third on the single-season mark.

DOUBLE-DIGIT HOMERS?

Charlie Marion (6) and Gabe Roessler (7) are currently on pace to eclipse double-digit home runs this season, the duo would be the first pair of Panthers to have at least 10 home runs since the 2006 campaign when Joe Nowikcki and Ross McCoy each had 11 round trippers that year.

ON BASE STREAKS

Caden Headlee has the longest active on-base streak off any Panther this season thus far, reaching base in 21 consecutive games, which includes hits in 17 of those contests.

Last season Gabe Roessler had a team-best 28-game on-base streak. Other streaks of at least 25 games over the last 20 seasons include Trevor Schwecke (26 games) in 2019, Daulton Varsho (41) in 2017, Luke Meeteer (25) in 2016, Sam Koenig (26) and Mitch Ghelfi (25) in 2015, Ryan Solberg (37) in 2014, Doug Dekoning (25) in 2011, Cole Kraft (28) in 2009, Jesse Hart (28) and Nick Wichser (25) in 2008, and Rob Brockel (34), Kyle Silver (29), and Nick Wichser (28) in 2007, Mike Goetz has the longest streak in that span with a 57-game on-base streak in 2006.

HIGH WATER STRIKEOUT MARK

With his eight strikeouts against Wright State on Mar. 21, Gavin Theis set the mark for most strikeouts in a single outing this season over six innings of work. Logan Schulfer previously held the mark with seven strikeouts twice this season.

In 2024, Adrian Montilva had 10 strikeouts against Purdue Fort Wayne, while Riley Frey had 10 against Wright State in 2023 and accomplished the number twice in 2022. Jack Mahoney was the last Panther pitcher to have more than 10 in a game with 11 against Oakland on May 1, 2021.

A PAIR OF FIVES

In the middle game of Milwaukee's road series at Youngstown State on Mar. 14 both Q Phillips and Gabe Roessler had five RBIs apiece in the lopsided 15-7 victory.

GAME NOTES

THREE STEALS IN A GAME

Gabe Roessler stole three bases in Saturday's series finale at Youngstown State on Mar. 15, he became the first Panther to swipe three bags in a game since he accomplished the same feat on May 5 last season against Purdue Fort Wayne. Milwaukee has now had 19 instances of a player stealing at least three bases in a game in program history, with the program record of four reached twice.

HIT BY PITCH

Six hit batters in a game by Milwaukee pitching was the program record for the Panthers entering play in 2025, last done on Feb. 22, 2008. This season the Panthers have hit seven batters twice in a game, during the nine-inning contest at Purdue on Mar. 18, before doing it again in the seven-inning affair two games later against Wright State on Mar. 21.

HOME COOKING

Over the last 20 seasons (2005-24), Milwaukee has taken the term 'home field advantage' to a new level, boasting winning seasons at home in all but two season (8-14 in 2022, 0-0 in 2020). The Panthers went unbeaten at home in 2013 (13-0), while the team has recorded back-to-back 12-7 marks in home games in both 2023 and 2024.

IN EXTRA INNINGS

This season, Milwaukee is 0-1 in extra-inning games, the Panthers hold a record of 16-17-1 in games needing extra frames dating back to the 2015 campaign.

TOP PROSPECT

D1Baseball announced its Top Prospects list for the 2025 season with Milwaukee right-handed pitcher Logan Schulfer named the third prospect on the list representing the Horizon League.

RETURNING TO WHERE IT ALL BEGAN

Among Milwaukee's transfers into the program is pitcher Logan Schulfer, who began his career with the Panthers in 2022 before transferring to Ball State for two seasons (2023-24).

Schulfer is one of just four active players in Division I to return to a school where they had previously played at the Division I level. Outfielder/Pitcher Malachi Lott returned to Houston, infielder Tristan Moore returned to New Orleans, and infielder Chandler Riley returned to Charlotte.

NEWLY ANNOUNCED ON THE HORIZON

The Horizon League announced the addition of Northern Illinois as the 12th full-time member. The Huskies will bring 14 sports to the league, including baseball beginning in 2026-27. Milwaukee will play Northern Illinois at home during non-conference play this season on Apr. 29. The Panthers are 35-29 in all-time meetings with the Huskies, including last season's 6-5 win.

Four players changed jersey numbers from what they wore a season ago including DJ Kojis (#21 to #8), Gavin Theis (#35 to #18), Tristan Arnold (#14 to #23), and Isaac Wenzel (#29 to #59).

TRAVEL POINTS

Wisconsin + Baseball + February is never a good mixture based on temperatures and potential snowfall in the Midwest, so the Milwaukee Panthers will once again open the season on an extended road trip. The trip will feature the first 19 games away from Franklin Field, spanning over 10,578 miles.

The Panthers will play in Georgia, Indiana, Illinois, Kansas, Minnesota, Nevada, Ohio, and South Carolina during its season-opening trip.

ANOTHER DRAFTEE

For the third consecutive season the Milwaukee baseball program had a player selected in the Major League Baseball First Year Player Draft in June. Owen Rice was selected in the 20th round of the 2024 draft by the St. Louis Cardinals, following the selections of Riley Frey in the 19th round of the 2023 draft by the Atlanta Braves, and the pick of AJ Blubaugh by the Houston Astros in the seventh round in 2023.

Milwaukee has had 26 all-time draftees with five of the last six draftees being pitchers. Five players are actively playing in either the Majors or Minor Leagues, including Milwaukee's first ever Major Leaguer in Daulton Varsho of the Toronto Blue Jays. Austin Schulfer signed a minor league deal with the Philadelphia Phillies entering the 2025 season, while Blubaugh (Houston), Frey (Atlanta), and Rice (St. Louis) are with minor league teams in their respective organizations.
