ATHLETICS COMPLIANCE

- **First Opportunity to Visit**

Sports Other Than Baseball, W. Basketball	August 1 of PSAs JR year
Baseball	Sept 1 of PSAs JR year
W. Basketball	Any time*
M. Basketball	August 1 beginning of Soph year*

*July evaluation period and College Basketball Academy restrictions (does not apply to transfers)

- **Requirements for an Unofficial Visit**

- Coaches must complete the unofficial visit request form per departmental procedures.

- **Unofficial Visit Limitations:**

- A PSA (or their family) may self-fund as many unofficial visits to campus.

- **Unofficial Visit Transportation:**

- The institution may not provide transportation to and from campus for an unofficial visit.
- The institution may provide transportation to the PSA and guests to view practice and competition sites in the PSA's sport, other institutional facilities, and to attend a home athletics competition at any local facility.
- The institution may use an institutional vehicle normally used to transport the team, or the personal vehicle of an institutional staff member (subject to university policy).
- An institutional staff member must accompany the PSA during such transportation.

- **Unofficial Visit Meals:**

- An institution may not pay for meals during an unofficial visit.
- It is permissible for coaches and PSAs to meet at a restaurant within one mile of campus (see below), provided that the PSA pays the costs of their meal(s).

- **Unofficial Visit Entertainment:**

- Complimentary Tickets:
 - a maximum of three complimentary admissions to a home athletics event at any facility within a 30-mile radius of the institution's main campus in which the institution's intercollegiate team practices or competes may be provided to a PSA.
 - Such complimentary admissions are for the exclusive use of the PSA and those persons accompanying the PSA on the visit and may be issued through digital ticketing or a pass list on an individual-game basis.
 - Such admissions may provide seating only in the general seating area of the facility used for conducting the event. Providing seating during the conduct of the event (including intermission) for the PSA or those persons accompanying

the PSA in the facility's press box, special seating box or bench area is specifically prohibited.

- Complimentary admission to conference and NCAA tournaments is prohibited.
- General Entertainment:
 - Entertainment expenses cannot be provided to a PSA during an unofficial visit.
- **Activities During Unofficial Visits:**
 - An institution may not arrange miscellaneous, personalized recruiting aids (e.g., personalized jerseys, personalized audio/video scoreboard presentations) and may not permit a PSA to engage in any game-day simulations (e.g., running onto the field with the team during pregame introductions) during an unofficial visit.
 - Personalized recruiting aids include any decorative items and special additions to any location outside of athletics facilities the PSA will visit (e.g., hotel room, dorm room, student union) regardless of whether the items include the PSA's name or picture.
 - An institution may decorate common areas in athletics facilities (e.g., lobby, coach's office, suite in arena) for an unofficial visit, provided the decorations are not personalized and the common areas are not accessible or visible to the general public while decorated.
- **Professional Tryout or Workout Activities:**
 - During an unofficial visit, a PSA may not attend events in which professional tryout or workout activities occur.
- **Off-Campus Contact Within One Mile of Campus Boundaries**
 - During an unofficial visit, off-campus contact between the PSA and institutional staff members that occurs within one-mile of campus boundaries is permissible.
 - Institutional staff members may meet at a restaurant, however, it is not permissible for institutional staff to cover the costs of any meals during an unofficial visit.
 - The institution may provide transportation to a location within one mile of campus.
