Head Coach Kris Kelderman



Kris Kelderman was named the seventh head coach in Milwaukee program history in May of 2012. It didn't take him long to make an impression with the Panthers, posting the first winning regular season for the team in seven years in his initial campaign in the fall of 2012.

He directed one of the youngest teams in the nation in 2015 – the Panthers had 14 freshmen and 21 total underclassmen on the roster – to mark the third-youngest team in the country. They competed each and every contest, with all but one of their losses on the year coming in a one-goal game and four going to overtime. That upward trend continued in 2016, as the team went 5-3-1 in league play and advanced to the semifinals of the Horizon League Tournament. Again, all but one loss on the season was a one-goal setback, with the Panthers spending time in the NSCAA regional rankings over the course of the campaign.

He enjoyed great success in 2013, guiding his team to a 15-3-2 record during the campaign, capped by the ninth NCAA Tournament appearance in program history. A 2013 WSA College Coach of the Year nominee, his turnaround of the program has been steady. The 15 victories in 2013 marked the most for UWM since 2003. They have also been very tough to beat at Engelmann Stadium under his watch, posting a 23-13-6 mark in that span.

UWM got off to a fast start in 2014, going 3-1 through four games to earn a regional ranking before injuries took their toll. The team was prolific on both sides of the ball in 2013. The offense led the Horizon League in nearly all categories, finishing 13th in scoring and 16th in total goals at the NCAA Division I level. It was just as good on defense, setting a school record with a 0.63 goals against average - breaking the mark of 0.67 set in 2002 - in ranking seventh in the NCAA in team GAA and 11th with its 10 shutouts.

The team got off to the second-best start in program history, posting a 9-0-1 record in the first 10 games before an overtime loss ended the streak. That stretch helped the Panthers earn their first national ranking since 2003, peaking at third in the region and 24th in the NSCAA (National Soccer Coaches Association of America) poll the week of Oct. 7.

He directed the team to an impressive 6-1 record at Engelmann Stadium his first season and helped the squad earn a spot in the NSCAA Regional Poll for the first time since 2005. Four players earned Horizon League postseason honors - the highest number in six years - as the team finished 8-8-2 overall.

Kelderman came to Milwaukee from Green Bay, where he spent the 2011 season as the head coach of the Phoenix. Prior to his time in Green Bay, Kelderman served four seasons as an assistant coach in MLS and two stints as an assistant coach at George Mason. He also played four seasons in MLS and a total of nine seasons in pro soccer.

A Neenah native, Kelderman was a two-time state champion and the

Wisconsin Gatorade Player of the Year in 1986 at Neenah High School while playing for his father, Harry. He actually won championships as a player at the high school, college and professional levels and was inducted into the Wisconsin State Soccer Association Hall of Fame in March 2010.

Kelderman's coaching career is highlighted by four seasons as the top assistant for two different teams in MLS. He worked with the Kansas City Wizards from 2007-09 and then spent the 2010 season with D.C. United. His time at George Mason included an NCAA Tournament appearance and top-25 ranking in 2005 and a second stint at the school before becoming the head coach at Green Bay.

Kelderman has also served as the technical director at Vienna Youth Soccer Club (2003-06) and Curt Onalfo Soccer, Inc. (2001-06), as the head coach and trainer with D.C. United Super Y-League U17 team (2004-06) and as the head coach of the Wisconsin Rebels (2000).

Kelderman guided Green Bay to an 11-7-1 record in 2011, making him just the third coach in Phoenix history to have 11 wins or more in his first season at the helm. Kelderman also helped Tony Walls to Horizon League Player of the Year honors and played a major role in helping Walls become the first player in Phoenix history to sign a professional contract with an MLS team.

Kelderman's professional playing career lasted nine seasons. He spent a total of four seasons with three teams in MLS, winning back-to-back championships while playing for D.C. United in 1996 and 1997. He then moved on to play for the Miami Fusion in 1998 and the New England Revolution in 1999. His pro career also included time with Milwaukee Rampage (1993-95, 2000) and Milwaukee Wave (2000-01) as well as stints with the St. Louis Ambush, Tampa Bay Terror, Buffalo Blizzard and Baltimore Blast.

Kelderman was a two-time All-Atlantic Coast Conference performer at the University of Virginia and helped the Cavaliers win the national championship in 1989. He closed out his career in the top-10 in both career points and assists in Virginia's record books. Kelderman also played on the Under-17 United States National Team in the U17 Youth World Cup in 1985.



Coaching Staff



Kyle Zenoni enters his third season as the associate head coach for the Milwaukee Panthers in 2017. This will be his sixth season overall after serving as the assistant coach for the first three years of his time back at UWM.

Zenoni returns to where he started his collegiate coaching career, having served as an assistant coach with the Panthers in 2010 before spending the 2011 campaign at Green Bay as an assistant on Kris Kelderman's staff with the Phoenix. In addition, he was a four-year letterwinner (2002-05) on the field for UWM.

"I am extremely excited to have Kyle on board with me as my right-hand man," Kris Kelderman said at the time of his hiring. "I was fortunate enough to have him with me in Green Bay and I hit the jackpot when he decided to come and join me again. He is a guy that knows a great deal about the game of soccer, he's a very hard worker and, most importantly, he's a very good person. Those are all things that are important to me and how I want to proceed and move forward with my staff and with this program."

Zenoni also provided an instrumental role for the Panthers in the spring of 2010 - serving as the interim coach and overseeing UWM through a 2-2-2 slate (4-2-0 after PK shootouts) that April.

"To be back at a school that I am so passionate about and to work with a guy like Kris Kelderman, words can't explain it," Zenoni said. "He is someone I look up to and I feel very fortunate to be a part of his staff once again. We did well at Green Bay and it will continue here at Milwaukee."

As a player, Zenoni led the Panthers to the second round of the NCAA Tournament each season he took the field. He was a four-year starter at Milwaukee - his 83 career games played ranks tied for seventh in program history - serving as team captain during his senior campaign.

After being selected by the Chicago Storm in the MISL Draft following his collegiate career, Zenoni traveled overseas to continue his professional career. He spent time with Dundee FC, a team in the Scottish Premier League, to begin his trek, while also playing for Falu FK (a Division 1 club in Sweden), La Paz FC (Premiership in South America) and with the Minnesota Thunder (USL) back in the United States.

In addition, his coaching career has included working for the Youth Development Program in Whitefish Bay, Wis. Other experience has come as an assistant for Milwaukee Area Technical College, with youth programs for the Milwaukee Kickers, working with Special Olympics and with the Sussex (Wis.) club team.



Agustin Rey joined the staff of Kris Kelderman as an assistant coach in the fall of 2016.

Rey wrapped up his playing career at Milwaukee in 2015, starting all 18 games as a senior in posting career highs in all categories. He posted a 1.07 goals-against average, 52 saves and three shutouts, finishing seventh in the Horizon League in both GAA and saves per game.

Rey posted his first career shutout with a pair of saves in 106 minutes of action against Oakland Sept. 19. He finished the season strong, recording shutouts in two of his final three starts - had clean sheets against Cleveland State Oct. 24, Western Illinois Oct. 27 and for the initial 77 minutes of the season finale against Northern Kentucky Nov. 6 - allowing just two goals over the final 450-plus minutes.

He has been a member of the College Sports Information Directors of America since 2001 and has received national publication awards from CoSIDA for his work on media guides 16 times, including "Third in the Nation" for the 2009 men's soccer guide, along with "Best in the Nation" for the 2009 cover.

He resides in West Bend with wife, Bridget, and two sons - Quinn, born in 2005, and Lucas, born in the summer of 2008.

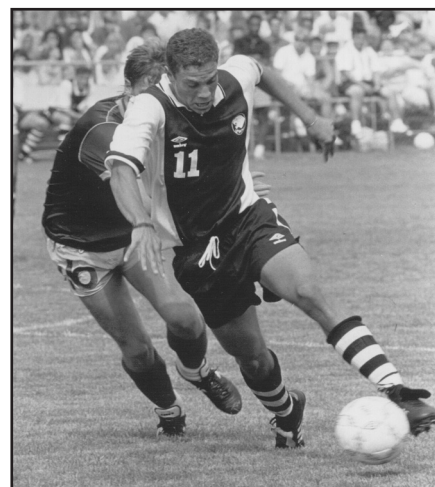

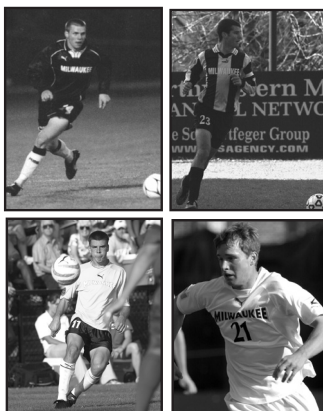
