Panthers Ready For Another Run At The Top

2014 proved to be an uncharacteristic season for Milwaukee women's track & field.

The team finished third at the Horizon League Indoor Championships and fourth and at the outdoor league meet last year. That marked the first time in program history they failed to finish in the top two at both league meets.

Now, that's largely a testament to how dominant the program has been since joining the league back in 1995. It also shows that Milwaukee was a young team last season. A young team that came on strong at the end.


UWM won six events at the outdoor league championships, a nod to what many say is the way of the future — with Milwaukee heading back toward the top.

"We've had some exceptional student-athletes come through our program throughout the years that have built an impressive legacy and high expectations," Milwaukee head coach Pete Corfeld said. "We have the talent to continue that legacy, we just need to continue to put in the hard work every day."

Sprints

Milwaukee had one of its most memorable seasons in recent memory in sprint events last year thanks in large part to the historic runs put in by Simbi Laaro. Then a junior, Laaro broke her own school record seemingly every time on the track last year, lowering the school record in the 60m to a blazing 7.37 seconds — one of the fastest times in the nation.

After cruising to a league title in the 60m and just missing a berth to the NCAA Indoor Championships in the same event, Laaro was slowed by injury during her outdoor campaign but figures to once again be a major contributor to Milwaukee's efforts this season.



Anuli Okonkwo showed just how far hard work can pay off, earning her first individual league title in the outdoor 400m last May. Now a junior, Okonkwo will look to build off last year's success.

CherRay Dixon also enters her junior season after earning a spot on the podium in both the 100m (fourth) and 60m (sixth) against the league one year ago.

Kate Novacek had a very strong freshman season last year. She was fourth in the indoor 400m, fifth in the outdoor 400m and was vital in Milwaukee's record-setting sprint relays.

Michelle Garner — although primarily a hurdler — also ran the indoor 400m, taking fifth with the seventh-fastest time in UWM history.

Alisha Harper now joins the talented group after a remarkable career in a variety of events at powerhouse Brookfield East High School.

Middle Distance

Then junior Dana Clausen stole the headlines for the middle distance group last season after claiming her first-ever league title in the outdoor 800m. Her time of 2:13.73 not only was nearly a full second ahead of the rest of the field, but it also now stands sixth overall in program history. Joining Clausen is a group of experienced and very talented individuals.

Sammy Woller is a senior who has scored in every event she competes in since the day she got to campus.

Leah Holmes is a sophomore who shined as a freshman, taking fourth in the 1500m, fifth in the outdoor 800m and just missing the podium in both indoor events. Holmes continues to improve, earning First-Team All-Horizon League honors in cross country after taking fourth overall in helping her team to a second-place finish at the league meet.



Brooke Jameson also is a part of the talented group, looking to make an impact after two years of battling injuries.

Distance

The Panthers just missed their first-ever Horizon League title in cross country this past November, coming in second overall after finishing last in the league just three years earlier.

Needless to say, the distance group for UWM has more than changed — starting first and foremost with this year's senior class.

Claira Himmel, Annette Lemanski and Emily Schaal have helped turn things around for the group during their time with Lemanski earning second-team all-league honors at the cross country championships this past fall.

Gayana Wanniarachchi and Ally Anich both have done very well in the Black in Gold in the past and are looking to bounce back after a frustrating fall campaign.

Hannah Jost is back for her sophomore season and joins redshirts Megan Tarlton, Miranda Tarlton and Austin Anderson as well as newcomers Alexis Willems, Leah Johnson, Jessie Laabs and Samantha Stone in the team's deepest group.

Hurdles

Milwaukee's hurdle group is arguably one of the deepest and most versatile in the





Sherice Hewett won a league title in 2013 but also specializes in jumps. Garner won a league title in the 400m hurdles last year but also is a very talented sprinter, contributing to UWM's outstanding relays. Sophomore Tess Nelson is a talented sprinter that has also run some cross country and scored in the multi events at last year's league meets.

All three return this year, but there is plenty more support to this group.

Chelsea Maxey is now a senior and has stood on the podium four different times for her efforts in hurdle events. After an up-and-down junior year, the standout will look to cap her career on a high note.

Morgan Torrence did well in her first year at the college level. Leah Wheaton returns from an injury that cut her entire freshman campaign short.

Halle Giaimo and Melissa Kirchoff also join the group as true freshman. Kirchoff took fourth in the 100m hurdles at last year's state meet, just ahead of Giaimo in eighth.

Relays

UWM has always been able to find some of the best combinations in the league when it comes to relays and last year was no different.

Okonkwo, Hewett, Dixon and Novacek teamed up to take a league title in the 4x100m relay with the fifth-fastest time in program history.

Milwaukee came in league runner-up in the 4x400m at the outdoor meet while posting the second-fastest time in UWM history in the same event earlier in the season.

The Panthers also posted a top-five time in program history in the DMR last year to add to an impressive season in relay events.

In fact, just one person from Milwaukee's four outstanding relays from last season graduate, leaving the Panthers in prime condition to build off that success in 2015.

Jumps

Milwaukee has been dominant in numerous events over the years, but perhaps none is more evident than triple jump. The Panthers have won a resounding seven-straight league indoor triple jump titles, while also taking four of the last five outdoor triple jump crowns.

That was no different last year as Hewett swept the event at both league meets. Hewett also finished runner-up in indoor long jump and third in outdoor long jump. Now a senior, the Division II All-American will look to wrap up her collegiate career continuing her dominating ways.

Ashley Brusveen also enters her senior campaign. A high jump specialist, Brusveen is already on the all-time top-10 list in the event during outdoor and will be a big leader for Milwaukee in her final season.



Kanika Bass finished just shy of a podium spot in outdoor triple jump last year and will look to build off of that this season.

There is also a large contingent of youth in the jump events this season.

As mentioned before, Kirchoff came in fourth in triple jump at the state meet just last year. That was right behind Harper, who was second in triple jump but earned a state title in long jump and flirted with the all-time state record. Meanwhile, Alize Souter also competed in two events at state, taking eighth in triple jump and 10th in high jump.

At the Division 2 level, Bryzena Santos also won a state title in long jump while taking fifth in triple jump.

Also, one year after having none on its roster, UWM has brought in three pole vaulters to fill a valuable role on the team. Rachael Whitefield and Mackenzie Nuthals both will exclusively compete in pole vault while Karlie Place will also split time with jumps.

Throws

After one year of learning from one of the best in Panther history in Nancy Harmon, Kamry Gipson is set to take over. The lone member of the group on this year's roster, Gipson will need to show her growth this spring to help bring Milwaukee back to where it wants to be.

Men's Track & Field Starts Pursuit For More Hardware In 2015

2014 was another outstanding year for Milwaukee track & field.

UWM claimed another Horizon League Indoor Championship and finished league runner-up during the outdoor season by a mere 10 points. The Panthers earned their secondstraight win at the historic Drake Relays and Durell Busby capped a remarkable career by earning First-Team All-American honors with a seventh place finish in the 110m hurdles at the NCAA Outdoor Championships.

With all those trophies and accolades from last year, it seems like it would be quite the challenge to duplicate last year's success. But, Milwaukee head coach Pete Corfeld says the team is more than ready to take on that challenge.

"Last year was another great season, but it was last year. We're ready to get out there this weekend and start a new chapter," Corfeld said. "We've had some exceptional student-athletes come through our program throughout the years that have built an impressive legacy and high expectations. We have the talent to continue that legacy, we just need to continue to put in the hard work every day."

Sprints

The Panthers have more than held their own in sprint events over the years. UWM placed seven on the podium in the three indoor sprint events and another seven during the outdoor championships. That includes defending league champion in both the indoor and outdoor 400m, Marquis Johnson, who enters just his junior season with lofty goals.



While Johnson is the headline grabber of the group, there is once again plenty of depth.

Matt Ferry enters his senior season after yet another strong showing last year, taking third in the 100m and fourth in the 60m at the league meets. Davontae Johnson finished last year on a strong note by making his way to the podium in both the 200m and 400m at the outdoor league championships.

Then comes a host of newcomers with very impressive resumes entering the college ranks.

Kyle Becker won a state title in the 400m and the 4x400m, while also finishing runner-up in the 100m and third in the 200m as a senior. Weston Guilfoyle was the state runner-up in the 100m and earned two other trips to the podium just last year. Alex Hatlevig also won a pair of state titles as a senior, nearly breaking a pair of state records in the process. Will Sutton also will run sprints while also focusing on other events.

Middle Distance

Milwaukee had one of its best seasons in recent memory in middle distance events in 2014. With the core of the group returning and some exciting additions to the team, 2015 could prove to be the best yet.

Jeff Pigg finished league runner-up in the indoor 800m to lead three Panthers to the podium, including Reed Schmidt, who was third in the 800m at the outdoor league meet. Both return with high hopes this season as Pigg enters his final year, while Schmidt is now a junior.

Fellow junior Tony Sustachek is coming off an outstanding season last year where he won his first league title, taking the top spot in the 1500m to top the very talented field. Sustachek also earned all-league honors in cross country this past fall and figures to be a key contributor this spring.

Sam Leschisin finished on the podium both during indoor and outdoor last year and is back for his final year, hoping to go out with a bang.

Also in the mix on the mid-distance crew are returner Caleb Abfall and newcomer Marcus Paulson. The duo both earned first-team all-league honors in cross country this past fall and will mix between mid and long-distance this year.

Distance

This past fall, Milwaukee missed its first-ever Horizon League Cross Country Championship Title by a mere two points. That's something that still sits with this very talented group of runners, led by newcomer Marcus Paulson.

Paulson ran away with a league title in cross country and the transfer senior should make a huge impact on the league landscape in every event he competes in this year.

Abfall also is coming off a strong cross country season where he took sixth overall to earn first-team all-league honors. He also was fifth in both the 1500m and steeple-chase at the outdoor league meet despite dealing with an injury that forced him to miss the entire fall season one year ago.

Adam Schueller enters his junior year after being named second-team all-league in cross country this fall with an 11th-place finish this past November. He also earned all-league honors at last year's indoor championships, taking fifth.

Joseph Morgan, Gerrit Bruni, Kurt Sustachek and Vince Paikowski are all back with various years of experience under their belts, while Garrett Miller, Ricardo Contreras, Alex Sayles and Brian Schafer all enter their first year of track and field.

Hurdles

Arguably the biggest group hit by graduation last year was the Panthers sterling hurdle group. Milwaukee won their second-straight Drake Relay title in the shuttle hurdles last season along with sweeping the hurdle events at the league meet for the third-straight year. The group closed out the year by adding another feather to its cap as Durell Busby was named First-Team All-American after finished seventh in the nation in the 110m hurdles.



With Busby (now competing on the international level) and Dexter Schleis (stands second in every hurdle event in school history) graduating, there will inevitably be questions surrounding this group for the first time in a while.

But there are still plenty of answers.

Jordan Schmidt nearly joined Busby at the NCAA Championships in both the 110m and 400m hurdles. Now a senior, Schmidt is the leader of the group. After earning his first individual league title in the 400m hurdles last year, he has high hopes for his last year on campus.

Nate Pozolinski came on strong last year as a freshmen taking fourth in the 60m hurdles, fifth in the 110m hurdles and seventh in the 400m hurdles at the league meets. He also was a part of the winning shuttle hurdle relay at the Drake Relays last year, an impressive feat for a true freshman.

Taylor Koss also came on strong as a freshman with a fourth-place finish in the 400m hurdles while also splitting time in sprint events.

Shawn Bohler is also a key returner, doing well in hurdle events in his first two years while focusing primarily on multi events.

Added to this year's mix is newcomer Ryan Vinhal. The freshman from Kettle Moraine High School is a four-time state qualifier and should do well with the leadership ahead of him.

Relays

It was a memorable year for Milwaukee's relays last year. The Panthers claimed league

titles in three of the four events at the league meets, including sweeping the 4x400m relay events. And, in addition to taking their second-straight victory lap at the Drake Relays following their shuttle hurdle title, Milwaukee also had a great run in the unique 4x200m relay at Drake, missing a school record by less than one-tenth of a second.

The majority of Milwaukee's relay groups return this year for what should be another promising season. J. Schmidt, M. Johnson and D. Johnson make up three-fourths of the outdoor 4x400m champs, while Pigg replaced D. Johnson to help claim the indoor title in the same event.

Ferry and D. Johnson return for the 4x100m relay to keep half that group intact with hopes of another league title hinging on a few other members of the team stepping up this year.

UWM came close to a school record in the DMR last year as T. Sustachek, J. Schmidt, Pigg and R. Schmidt posted the fourth-fastest time in school history. Those four plus others should be key contributors yet again this year.



Jumps

One spot that was easily overlooked at the 2014 Horizon League Indoor Championships was the performance put on by Brett Pozolinski. Then just a sophomore, Pozolinski not only won his first league title in high jump, but did so in remarkable fashion by nearly breaking the school and league record. Now a junior, Pozolinski figures to have yet another strong season.

Also in the high jump group, Nick Hughes enters his senior season after what seems

like two full years of battling various injuries. After capping last year with a third-place finish at the league meet, Hughes looks to regain his form and end his career on a strong note.

Alex Butovskiy heads into his junior season as a high jumper. With two solid years under his belt, high jump should be a very deep group for the team this season.

After battling injuries all of 2013, Aaron Dillon returned to form by scoring in both triple jump and high jump at both indoor and outdoor league meets last season.

In long jump, Nate Havener joins Ferry, Bohler and N. Pozolinski as the key returners.

Additionally, Milwaukee adds what figures to be two key pieces in Cody Zaeske and Trevor James. A transfer from Oklahoma, Zaeske won state titles in both long and triple jump at East Troy his junior year and still holds the state record in long jump. Meanwhile, James is an NCAA Division III Champion in high jump, competing at the national meet three times while at Carthage College.

Throws

2014 was an outstanding year for Milwaukee in throwing events. Nearly every member of the team set new personal records in every event, which led to a pair of league titles for the group.

Alex Chollet is the lead returner after breaking the school record in weight throw last season and adding his name to the all-time school record lists in seemingly every event just last year. Chollet also took home a league title in discus after nearly breaking the league record.

Classmate Jake Goodwiler has improved every season and figures to once again be a key contributor, especially in hammer throw where he is fourth in school history.

Sam Robinson enters his junior season and Silas Petrie will now be a sophomore. Both continued to do well last season and will be important parts of the puzzle for Milwaukee to add more hardware to their trophy case in 2015.

Cross Country, Distance, Middle Distance, Throws

In his 26th season as the head men's and women's cross country and track and field coach, Pete Corfeld continues to make his mark as one of the most successful coaches the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee has ever seen.

Corfeld has guided his teams to 46 league indoor and outdoor track titles and three cross country crowns. His 49 league titles are by far more than any other coach in school history. Last year, the men won the indoor title in dramatic fashion with an incredible team performance in the final 4x400 relay. The team also saw its streak of 10-straight outdoor titles come to a close, a run that was the longest in the nation.

Historically, Milwaukee has swept all four track league titles four times in one season, most recently in 2011. UWM also claimed all four track championships in 2001, 2007 and 2010.

Individually, Panther athletes had another banner year in 2013-14. They claimed the women's indoor and men's outdoor league athlete of the year awards last year, while the program accumulated 22 individual championships over the indoor and outdoor seasons.

NCAA Qualifiers Under Corfeld

UWM has had a rich history of producing NCAA Qualifiers during the tenure of coach Pete Corfeld. The Panthers have had seven NCAA Qualifiers and one U.S. Olympic Trials qualifier under Corfeld's instruction.

The success has not ended at the league meet, as Milwaukee sent four studentathletes to compete in six events at the NCAA West Regional, despite the NCAA's stricter qualifications regionals and the reduction of regional meets. Out of the four, Durell Busby earned a trip to the NCAA Championships and was named First-Team All-American after finishing seventh overall in the nation in the 110m hurdles. Busby also nearly represented the Black & Gold on the inter-



national level, earning a spot at the prestigious Commonwealth Games for his home nation of Trinidad & Tobago.

Last season's indoor title was the 10th in the last 11 years for the Milwaukee men's program. All told, the men's program has won 30 of the last 35 league meets. That stretch includes 15 of the 17 outdoor championships the league has sponsored.

While the men have found unparalleled success, the women have not been far behind. In fact, over the last 35 league meets dating back to 1997, Milwaukee has failed to secure a top-two finish just four times. That string includes 16 league championships.

Both teams have been dominant in their success as four times a Panther team has won a league meet by over 100 points. The program holds league records on both the men's and women's sides for points in an outdoor championship and margin of victory. In 2003, UWM won the women's title with 252 points, 171 ahead of second place. Two years later, it was the men that tallied 231 points, pacing second place by 120.

Corfeld has been recognized for his success many time over, garnering League Coach of the Year honors 49 times in his career. He has coached 12 league athletes of the year and 80 outstanding performer and newcomer of the year recipients. Tenia Fisher (2003-06) was just the second athlete in league history, in any sport, to be recognized as athlete of the year three times in one sport (indoor track).

Corfeld works primarily with the middle distance and distance groups in addition to the cross country squads. UWM had the 10th-fastest 4x800m relay in the country in 2005, with the quartet posting a school-record time of 7:26.17.





Corfeld's cross country program has produced 68 all-league performers since the Panthers entered a conference for the 1992 season. He has also coached two individual champions and three newcomer of the year honorees.

In 2008, the Milwaukee women took second place at the league championship and had four runners earn all-league honors for the second-straight year. For the 2008 team, three of those all-league awards were first-team honors. The secondplace finishes are the team's best since joining the Horizon League. In 2007, allleague first-teamer Holly Nearman took 12th at the NCAA Great Lakes Regional for all-region honors. It was the highest finish at a Division I regional by a Panther ever. He was also named league coach of the year, the first time in league history the award went to the second-place team coach.

Despite not winning a cross country championship since leaving the Mid-Continent Conference, UWM has continually performed in the upper half of the league standings. After winning a women's crown in 1992 and both the men's and women's championships in 1993, Milwaukee has boasted a pair of men's league individual champions while rarely finishing below fourth.

Corfeld, the longest-tenured coach currently at UWM, has built well-respected track and field and cross country teams that consistently compete with other schools across the league, region and country.

Under his direction, nine different student-athletes have qualified for the NCAA Championships. In addition to Busby, Samia Taylor, Nick Gretz, Tim Kenney, Cory Peterson and Angie Molter all competed at the NCAA Track and Field Championships, while Chad Zehms was a qualifier in the NCAA Cross Country Championships in 1995. Peterson would later make two more appearances in the NCAA Championships, along with qualifying for the U.S. Olympic Trials in the 800m run in 1996 and placing third in the 800m at the USATF Indoor Championships. Molter was the first UWM female to compete in the NCAA Division I Championships, running the 10,000m in 1996.

Corfeld's athletes have also excelled off the track, as Josh Nygren earned the Horizon League's prestigious Coleman Medal of Honor in 2006. He was the program's third recipient of the honor after Paul McGinley in 2000 and Jonathon Manke in 2002.

Corfeld's coaching career began at St. Mary's Academy in 1980. Three years later he became the head track and field coach at Milwaukee Area Technical College. At MATC, he was named Region XIII and conference coach of the year three times. Corfeld graduated from UWM in 1986 with a bachelor's degree in science. He was then named assistant coach for sprints, hurdles and relays at Northern Colorado, where he also worked on a master's degree. In 1989, after completing his degree, he was named the head cross country and track and field coach at UWM. Since taking over the Panther track program, Corfeld has helped to elevate UWM to a regional and national program.

Corfeld and his wife, Linda, reside in Whitefish Bay, Wis.

Eric **KRAMER**

Assistant Coach • Third Year St. Joseph's, 2007 Sprints, Hurdles

Eric Kramer is in his third season as assistant coach for the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee men's and women's track & field teams.

In his first two seasons with Milwaukee, Kramer helped guide UWM to a Horizon League Men's Outdoor Championship in 2012 and an indoor league title in 2013. Also, Panther student-athletes have produced an impressive 43 Horizon League individual titles in his first two years on campus.

In 2014, Kramer helped coach Durell Busby to First-Team All-American honors after taking seventh in the nation in the 110m hurdles at the NCAA Outdoor Championships in Eugene, Ore.

It wasn't just Busby though, as Milwaukee has dominated hurdle events the past two years, winning eight of the 12 possible league titles in those events in absolutely dominating fashion - placing a whopping 31 individuals on the podium in those 12 events, including taking the top-five spots in the 60m hurdles in 2014.

That talent has also shone through at the national level as UWM has earned the nation's top honor for their 4x110m shuttle hurdle relay team that won back-to-back Drake Relay titles in 2013 and 2014.

In 2013, Kramer helped then-freshman Marquis Johnson earn Junior All-American status after a seventh-place finish at the USA Outdoor Track & Field Championships in Des Moines, Iowa.

Milwaukee has earned eight berths to the NCAA West Regional thus far under Kramer's tutelage, including Busby's historic run in 2014.

Kramer came to Milwaukee after spending the past year at Franklin College.

At Franklin College, Kramer helped lead the Grizzlies to impressive heights. In 2012, the team posted six school records between the sprint, hurdle and jump events that Kramer coached. He also served as the meet director for the inaugural Indiana D-III Championships and the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference Championship meet.

Kramer also started out his coaching career at Franklin from 2007-2009, quickly becoming an integral part of the coaching staff. In that time, he helped coach the team to the conference indoor title. He also coached two HCAC Most Valuable Track Athlete of the Year winners and two Academic All-Americans. Additionally, he also guided the school to their first-ever men's and women's cross country league championship titles, including having one men's national qualifier.

In between, Kramer spent two years at Lake Erie College where he helped send numerous student-athletes to the NCAA D-II Championships and produced 11 All-Americans and an outstanding 31 school records. Kramer also helped coach the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference Outdoor Track Athlete of the Year.

Jake **REILLY**

Assistant Coach • First Year Milwaukee, 2013 Cross Country, Distance

Jake Reilly joined the Milwaukee coaching staff in 2014 as an assistant with the Panther track and cross country programs.

Reilly served as a student assistant in the 2013 season before joining the staff full time. He assists head coach Pete Corfeld with the distance runners and cross country teams.

"As a former athlete that has gone through the program, Jake is able to enlighten the younger athletes on its nuances," Corfeld said. "He is still training at a high level and the example he sets is a great motivator for the team."

Reilly joined the coaching staff after four years as a member of Milwaukee's distance and cross country corps.

In his career, Reilly was a consistent leader for UWM. Running in the Black & Gold from 2009-13, he was a two-time all-league first-team honoree in cross country in his career - highlighted by a third-place finish at the league meet his senior season. On the track, Reilly is among the school's all-time leaders in the indoor 3,000m, as well as the outdoor 1,500m and 5000m. his 5K time of 14:36.81 still stands second in program history.







Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference

Like a majority of the schools in the University of Wisconsin System, Milwaukee spent time in the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC).

The University began competition in the Wisconsin Normal Conference in 1913, with records indicating the men's team had won the inaugural track & field championships in 1915.

The conference, as well as member institutions underwent multiple name changes, eventually becoming the Wisconsin State University Conference (WSUC). UWM left the WSUC in 1964.

Records indicate the Milwaukee women competed in the Women's WIAC (WWIAC) from 1976 until 1984. The conference instituted an indoor league meet beginning in 1977.

In 1997, the WSUC and WWIAC merged to form the co-ed WIAC.

Men's WSUC Championships

The University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee is on record as having won 33 WSUC Outdoor Championships in the 46 years between 1915 and 1964. The Green Gulls, as was the school's nickname from 1927-56, won 26-straight titles from 1928-53. There were no championship meets for four years during World War II from 1943-46.
