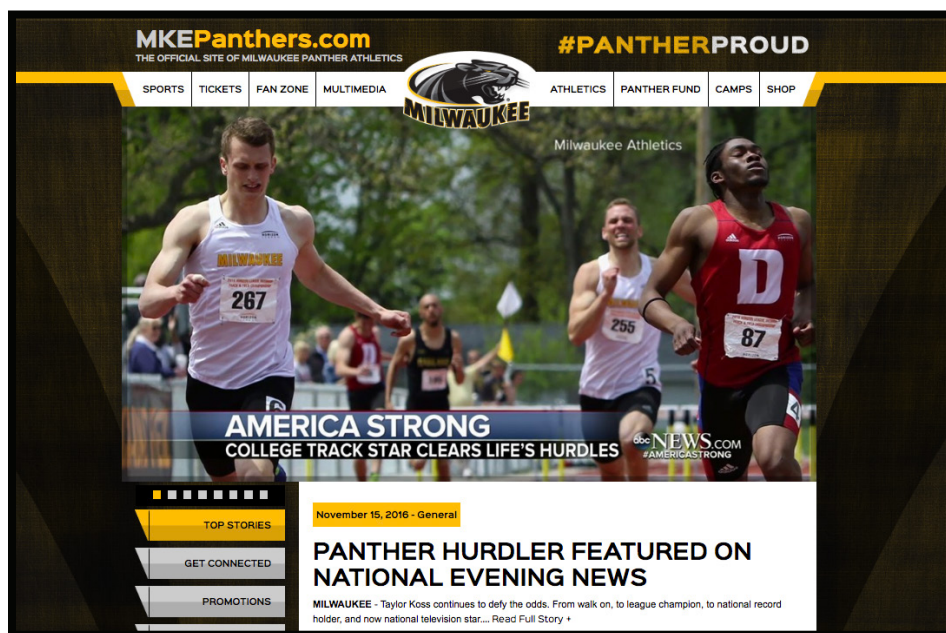

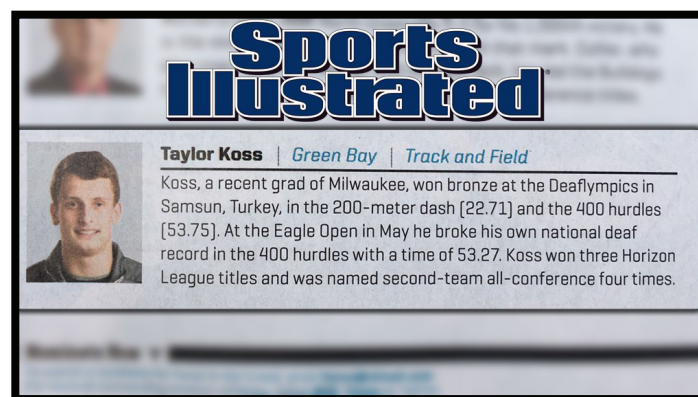

UW-LA CROSSE '02

Andrew Basler has been hired as the new head coach of the Milwaukee track & field and cross country programs.

"After an extensive national search that produced a group of highly-qualified finalists, Andrew quickly rose to the top as our choice to lead the program," Braun said. "His background of success on both the conference and national level is impressive and we believe he can help us take the program to the next level."

Basler comes to Milwaukee following five years as the assistant men's and women's track & field coach at Central Michigan University. He also served as a graduate assistant coach at CMU from 2005-07.

"I am extremely excited to join the Panther Family," Basler said. "I am very thankful to Amanda Braun and Kathy Litzau and the rest of the search committee for this process and having the confidence in me to be able to step in, fill some big shoes, and be the next head coach at Milwaukee."

"There is a rich history and tradition of winning at Milwaukee. I am excited for the challenge that will bring and for the opportunity to be able to grow on that. I am looking to bring in a new energy and a new passion. I am excited to get there and get the ball rolling – meet the staff and sit down with the athletes and get a chance to get to know them."

Most recently at CMU, Basler assisted the head coach with all administration of the program while also writing and implementing training programs for jumps and combined events. He helped in recruiting and also planned and budgeted for all team travel. During his first stint at CMU, Basler was in charge of sprints, jumps, hurdles and combined events with the Chippewas.

Under his watch, the program achieved a pair of USA Olympic Trials Qualifiers, three USA Outdoor Track and Field National Championships Qualifiers and three USA Junior Outdoor Track and Field Championships Qualifiers.

At the NCAA level, the list included three NCAA Division I Outdoor National Championships participants, 10 NCAA Division I Outdoor East Prelims/Regional participants, two NCAA Division I Indoor National Championships participants and an NCAA Division I Indoor All-American.

At the conference level, the program claimed seven Indoor/Outdoor Mid-American Conference (MAC) champions, 14 Indoor/Outdoor MAC All-Conference selections, three Indoor/Outdoor MAC record-holders, one Outdoor MAC Championship record-holder and 16 Indoor/Outdoor school record-holders.

From 2007-13, Basler was the associate head women's track and field coach and the assistant men's coach at UC Riverside, where he worked directly with the sprints, hurdles, jumps, javelin and combined-events.

Administratively, Basler managed the program's travel and equipment budgets while also serving as meet director for home track and field and cross country meets, including the Big West Conference Championships from 2008-12.

At UC-Riverside, Basler coached six USA Outdoor Track and Field Championships qualifiers, five USA Junior National Championships qualifiers, two USA Indoor National Championships qualifiers, five NCAA All-Americans (combined indoor and outdoor), 19 NCAA Division I Outdoor West Prelims/Regional participants, 12 Big West outdoor conference champions and 37 school record holders (combined indoor and outdoor).

During Basler's years of coaching, he has also coached multiple post-collegiate athletes on the national and international stages. Highlights of his post-collegiate coaching include guiding Riverside alum Ted Hooper (long jump) to the 2016 Indoor World Championships, as well as second-place finishes at the 2015 Indoor USA Championships, 2015 Taiwan Open Athletic Championships, and the 2015 Asian Athletic Championships. In addition, Basler helped guide Riverside alum Allison Wilder (triple jump) to a third-place medal at the 2016 British Indoor Championships.

Under the tutelage of coach Mark Guthrie at Wisconsin-La Crosse, Basler won the 2002 NCAA Division III indoor national title in the long jump. He was a three-time NCAA Division III All-American and was the captain of La Crosse's teams that swept the indoor and outdoor NCAA team championships in 2001 and 2002.

Basler earned a Bachelor of Science degree in art from La Crosse in 2002 and his a Master of Arts in Sport Administration degree from Central Michigan in 2014.

Jake Reilly enters his fifth season as the top assistant coach for the Milwaukee cross country teams in 2018-19. That comes after one year helping coach the team as a student assistant while completing his track & field eligibility.

The 2017-18 season was truly a special one for Milwaukee's distance program. In track, Milwaukee racked up a whopping 88 points at the Horizon League Championships between indoor and outdoor.

The most impressive showing came in the outdoor 800m where Milwaukee took three of the top-four spots. Drew Dueck just beat out teammate Alex Cotter for a 1-2 finish, with newcomer Michael Sippy taking fourth. That marked the first time a Panther had won the event since Jeremy Majors did so three years in a row from 2005-07. Reilly also coached Terry McMillan to runner-up finishes in the 1500m and steeplechase, as well as the indoor mile. McMillan also earned all-league honors in cross country after taking ninth overall.

That came just one year after the men's distance program racked up an impressive 56 points at the league meets in 2016. That feat was highlighted with Milwaukee runners nearly completing a sweep of the medals in the outdoor 800m, taking second, third and fourth overall in an incredible photo finish. In fact, four more Panthers scored in the women's 800m, giving Milwaukee seven scorers in the event and a total of 35 points - nearly half of the total possible.

In 2015, Leah Holmes finished as the Horizon League Cross Country Runner of the Year on the women's side - the second-straight year the Panthers have boasted the league's top runner. Holmes' title was the first ever for a Panther woman at the league meet. Holmes also was named Horizon League Athlete of the Year in both cross country and indoor track & field that season.

That came on the heels of a truly memorable 2014 season that saw both the men's and women's cross country teams finished second overall at the Horizon League Championships - the highest combined finish for both programs since 1996.

Reilly coached Marcus Paulson to an individual league title - the first individual men's title in nearly 20 years. Three more earned all-league honors on the men's side as UWM finished with 59 points - a mere two points shy of a league title.

The Panther women also finished league runners-up, doing so for the first time since back-to-back second-place finishes in 2007 and 2008. Sophomore Leah Holmes and senior Annette Lemanski both earned all-league honors to help pace UWM.

At the 2014 NCAA Midwest Regional, Milwaukee had two finish in the top-65 for the first time since 1997. Paulson finished 57th and Caleb Abfall 64th to help the team to a 15th-place finish out of 30 teams.

Reilly has also made impressive strides on the recruiting trail, bringing in highly sought after Noah Tagliapietra to join the Black & Gold.

Reilly had a stellar running career at Milwaukee. In cross country, he scored at the league meet all four years, highlighted by a pair of first-team all-league finishes (fourth place as a junior, third as a senior). He also had a standout career on the track, taking second-team all-league honors in the outdoor 5000m as a junior. In all, Reilly scored at the league meet nine times in track across three different events (1500m, 3000m and 5k). He graduated with his name on five all-time top-10 performance lists in program history, including being part of the school record in the outdoor DMR and second all-time in the outdoor 5000m.

Reilly also serves his country as a member of the United State Marine Corps Reserves.

Joe Brunner joined the Milwaukee track & field coaching staff in the fall of 2015 and specializes in coaching throws for the Panthers.

In just three seasons with the Panthers, he has already made a big impact. At the Horizon League Championships, Milwaukee placed on the podium 74 times in the six throwing events between indoor and outdoor over the past three years - including an incredible 29 during last year's campaign. In fact, the Panthers have won five league titles under Brunner's guidance and finished runner-up nine more times.

Also on his watch, Silas Petrie qualified for the NCAA West Regional in hammer throw and Peter Andrew qualified in shot put. Additionally, Panther throwers were named league athletes of the week 12 times since he joined the coaching staff.

The Panther record board has also changed quite a bit since Brunner came to campus, with five top marks already reset since 2015.

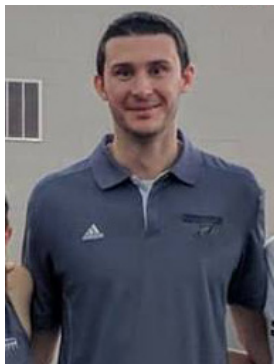
The 2018 season was a banner one for Milwaukee's throwing events. Peter Andrew grabbed most of the headlines by sweeping the indoor and outdoor titles in shot put, breaking both school records along the way. Andrew advanced to regionals, where his outstanding junior season fell just short of a berth to nationals.

Steph Kostowicz also broke her own school record in shot put multiple times over the year despite spending the majority of her time with the Panther basketball team.

At the Horizon League Championships, the MKE men racked up 36 points during indoor and 48 points at outdoor, taking the top-two spots in shot put at both championships.

Brunner brings a wealth of experience in throws to Milwaukee. A standout in college at UW-Oshkosh, he earned All-American honors in 35 lb. weight throw.

Additionally, Brunner qualified for nationals three times for the Titans and won a conference title in hammer throw in the highly competitive Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference.

Garrett Huyler (pronounced HIGH-ler) joined the Milwaukee track & field coaching staff in the fall of 2010. Since he came aboard, he has done nothing but continue the rich Panther tradition, helping UWM win a total of 11 Horizon League team titles in that time.

Working specifically with high jumpers, Huyler has seen incredible success from his student-athletes. Milwaukee high jumpers have won an outstanding 10 league titles and another 13 second-team all-league finishes in his seven years with the program.

Huyler helped bring home another individual title in 2018. In fact, sophomores Brady Irwin and Trevor Coenen each cleared personal bests at the indoor championships to bring home the gold and silver medals as Milwaukee placed six on the podium that day for a combined 32.5 points - with five of the six jumpers clearing new PRs.

With a very young group in 2017, Huyler once again showed his coaching capabilities by guiding the youthful squad to outstanding showings at the Horizon League Championships. Milwaukee took up 12 spots on the podium between men and women, indoor and outdoor at the 2017 league championships, headlined by a league title by Jason Hanson in just his freshman year. Even more impressive, at the outdoor league meet, Milwaukee high jumpers scored 38.5 points, equaling the total of all other schools combined.

2016 was a banner year for Milwaukee high jumpers. Senior Brett Pozolinski qualified for both the indoor and outdoor NCAA Championships, becoming the first-ever Panther to do so in the D-I era. Pozolinski finished tied for fifth at indoor nationals and was 10th at Track Town in Eugene, Ore. at the outdoor championships to claim All-American honors at both meets.

Huyler also coached Laura Hamel to the NCAA West Regionals in 2012, and has coached three school record holders.

While coaching, Huyler has also continued his professional jumping career, competing at a variety of national events. He has represented the U.S. in international competitions in seven different foreign countries and boasts personal bests of 2.25m (7-4 1/2) in outdoor and 2.24m (6-4 1/4) in indoor. His competition reached its pinnacle in the summer of 2016, qualifying for the U.S. Olympic Trials in Eugene, Ore., just missing a berth to the Rio Olympics.

Huyler comes to Milwaukee after four outstanding years at Ivy-League power Cornell University. During his time at Cornell, the team captain helped the Big Red win seven of the possible eight conference titles and was a First-Team All-American high jumper after finishing eighth at the 2009 NCAA Outdoor Championships. He also won three individual league titles and graduated with both indoor and outdoor school records to his name.

Huyler and his wife, Kelly, live in Oak Creek.

Both Jayde Wollenberg and Jack Johnson scored in their first collegiate season in pole vault for Milwaukee to add valuable points. In fact, Johnson's performance at the outdoor championships was one the highlights of the season for Schmidt's pole vaulters, as Johnson battled through injury and adjusted his approach at the last minute to still bring home fourth place.

In just his first year, Schmidt helped coach the first men's indoor pole vault champion for Milwaukee since 2013 in Nate Scherer. The sophomore cleared a PR height at the conference meet to bring home his first league title.

Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference

Like a majority of the schools in the University of Wisconsin System, Milwaukee spent time in the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC).

The University began competition in the Wisconsin Normal Conference in 1913, with records indicating the men's team had won the inaugural track & field championships in 1915.

The conference, as well as member institutions underwent multiple name changes, eventually becoming the Wisconsin State University Conference (WSUC). UWM left the WSUC in 1964.

Records indicate the Milwaukee women competed in the Women's WIAC (WWIAC) from 1976 until 1984. The conference instituted an indoor league meet beginning in 1977.

In 1997, the WSUC and WWIAC merged to form the co-ed WIAC.

Men's WSUC Championships

The University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee is on record as having won 33 WSUC Outdoor Championships in the 46 years between 1915 and 1964. The Green Gulls, as was the school's nickname from 1927-56, won 26-straight titles from 1928-53. There were no championship meets for four years during World War II from 1943-46.
