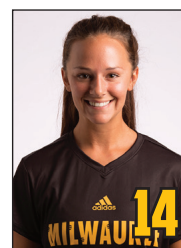

Head Coach Troy Fabiano



The 2017 season will be the third for **Troy Fabiano** as the Milwaukee women's soccer coach.

Fabiano set the bar high his first two seasons, compiling a record of 24-8-6 while claiming back-to-back Horizon League regular-season titles on the strength of a 16-1-1 mark in league play. His 24 victories are the most-ever for a UWM head coach in their first two seasons.

The two-time Horizon League Coach of the Year led a squad that topped the Horizon League in points, goals, assists and shots on offense and shutouts and goals-against average on defense in 2016, coming up just short of a return to the NCAA Tournament after a tough loss in the title game.

In 2015, he quickly turned around a team that won just six games the year prior to his arrival and was picked to finish eighth in the preseason poll. He nearly doubled that win total, with his team finishing 11-3-4 overall, including an unbeaten 8-0-1 mark in league play that included the regular-season crown.

That title put the Panthers back on top of the conference for the 15th time in the past 16 seasons, led by a defense that topped the Horizon League with its 0.69 goals-against average and nine shutouts. Seven different players went on to earn Horizon League post-season honors.

Fabiano came to Milwaukee following 17 years as the head women's soccer coach at the University of Wisconsin-Parkside, where he compiled a remarkable .770 winning percentage and boasted a 222-74-29 record.

"We are very excited to have someone with Troy's tremendous experience join our team," Director of Athletics Amanda Braun said at the time of Fabiano's hire. "He is a great coach and recruiter and he is a proven winner. We're looking forward to having him in Milwaukee working as an educator and leader for our young women."

Fabiano became the eighth coach in Milwaukee program history, and took over a program that made 11 NCAA Tournament appearances, won 15 regular season league titles and claimed 10 league tournament trophies prior to his arrival.

"I'd like to thank Amanda Braun, Kathy Litzau and the entire search committee for entrusting me with the opportunity to lead the Milwaukee women's soccer program into the future," Fabiano said. "It's a great opportunity for me and my family. Throughout the process, I was really impressed with everybody in the athletic department and their vision for the program moving forward."

"It was very noticeable how tightly knit the Panther community is and the support the coaches have to be successful, both on and off the field."

Fabiano guided Parkside to 16 consecutive winning seasons, eight NCAA Tournament appearances and five Great Lakes Valley Conference championships. He earned three GLVC Coach of the Year awards, and was named the Midwest Region Coach of the Year in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

During his time with the Rangers he helped coach seven All-Americans, including one Capital One Academic All-American First-Team selection in 2014.

Fabiano guided Parkside to another memorable season his final year, finishing with an 18-1-3 record and a berth in the NCAA Sweet 16 before falling to the eventual national champion in overtime. The Rangers were also ranked as high as No. 3 in the nation during a 2014 campaign that saw them clinch both the GLVC regular season and tournament titles. His team also boasted the best goals-against average in the nation that season, yielding just 0.265 per game.

Fabiano began his coaching career as a men's assistant at his alma mater, Robert Morris. He then went on to become the interim head men's coach at NCAA Division I Eastern Illinois, before returning to his hometown of Kenosha to take the assistant position with the Parkside women's program in 1996. After one season, Fabiano was promoted to head coach and he led the Rangers to the GLVC's Final Four in just his third year at the helm and to the league championship game one season later.

Fabiano had a superlative playing career before going on to be a highly successful coach. He played locally at Kenosha Bradford High School before earning a scholarship to play soccer at Robert Morris University. While with the Colonials, Fabiano was member of the All-Northeast Conference first team all four years. He was the Northeast Conference Player of the Year and finished 10th in the nation in scoring as a senior.

Fabiano's soccer skills were employed in the professional ranks after his term at Robert Morris. He played one season with the Pittsburgh Stingers of the CISL; one season with perennial power Milwaukee Wave of the NPSL; and one season with the Milwaukee Rampage of the USISL.



Coaching Staff



Steve Golas joined the Milwaukee women's soccer coaching staff in the spring of 2015.

He quickly helped turned around a team that won just six games the year prior to his arrival and was picked to finish eighth in the preseason poll. The squad repeated as league champions again in 2016 at 8-1-0, topping the Horizon League in points, goals, assists and shots on offense and shut-outs and goals-against average on defense, coming up just short of a return to the NCAA Tournament after a tough loss in the title game.

Golas brings a wealth of knowledge and experience and an incredibly high energy level and passion for the game to UWM. He has over 15 years of coaching experience under his belt, including serving most recently as the first-ever head women's coach at Texas A&M-Texarkana.

Golas comes to Milwaukee having found success at every level and has been a part of some remarkable winning transitions at various institutions. In the inaugural season of the TAMUT program, Golas helped the team to a 10-2-3 overall record, outscoring opponents by a combined score of 58-15 on the year.

Prior to that, Golas spent four years as the head coach for the men's squad and assistant women's soccer coach at Illinois College. During his tenure, he became the men's all-time leader in coaching victories. He led the Blue-boys to their first winning season in nearly 20 years in 2011 and compiled a 10-6-2 mark in 2013.

Golas began his coaching career at Bemidji State University helping lead the team to a then-school record win total and one of the biggest turn-arounds in the nation in 2000.

Golas moved on to William Penn University in 2002 where he served one season as an assistant women's coach and associate men's head coach. The women's squad won the MCC championship and advanced all the way to the Region VII championship game. The men had similar success posting a school-record 11-5-2 season after finishing 5-11-2 the year before. Golas was named head men's coach at the conclusion of the season and watched his 2003 squad post a 10-6-1 record while breaking numerous school records and finishing the season ranked number two in NAIA Region VII.

Golas then moved on to Angelo State University as an assistant women's coach. He helped lead the team to its first ever back-to-back 10-win seasons, and the school earned post-season LSC Tournament berths as well as its highest-ever regional ranking during his tenure.

Prior to his arrival at Lewis & Clark, Golas led Millikin University to one of the most significant single-season turnarounds in NCAA history. The 2006 Millikin women's squad posted a 2-13 record. He led the 2007 Millikin team to a 12-7 record while breaking 17 school records along the way and posting one of the nation's top 10 scoring offenses.

Golas played collegiately at Coe College where he was a four-year letter winner for the Kohawks and twice was recognized as the team's most improved player. He was also a member of the Coe track & field team.

Golas earned his bachelor's degree from Coe College in 1998 and received his master's degree in Sports Studies from Bemidji State in 2002.

Golas joined the staff after spending the 2014 season at Texas A&M-Texarkana, serving as the athletics business manager. Her husband, Steve Golas, who also joined the Milwaukee coaching staff, was at the school as the women's soccer head coach.

Prior to the move to Texas, Golas was the women's head coach at Illinois College for four seasons. That followed a two-year stay at Lewis & Clark in Portland, Ore., as the women's assistant with Steve the head coach.

Golas has a resume of great success over her coaching career. Her first stop came at Michigan State (2003-05), where she helped the team compile a 21-13-0 record. She then moved on to serve as an assistant at Angelo State University (2005) and Millikin University (2006-07). Golas also has made an impact at the club level leading her Chicago Blast U-12's to a National Indoor Soccer Championship as well as winning an IWSL league title. She also worked with the Illinois Fusion Soccer Club leading her team to a CISL championship in 2008.

A talented collegiate athlete, she began her playing career at Bemidji State University. During her time at BSU, she held nearly every offensive record and was a three-time All-NSIC First-Team honoree. Along the way she was also recognized as BSU's Female Athlete of the Year, a NSIC Academic All-Conference member and was the school's inaugural inductee into its soccer hall of fame.

Golas finished her playing career at the University of Wisconsin-Parkside under Fabiano, where she helped anchor one of the nation's premier defenses and was recognized as an Academic All-GLVC performer for her efforts.

Golas received her bachelor's degree, graduating Magna Cum Laude, from UW-Parkside in 2003 and received her master's degree in Forensic Science from Michigan State University in 2008. She and her husband Steve have a son, Jacoby, and a daughter, Cora.

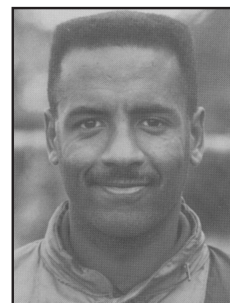

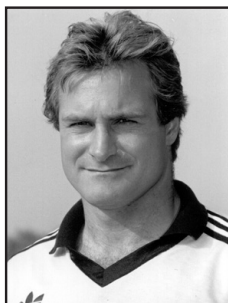

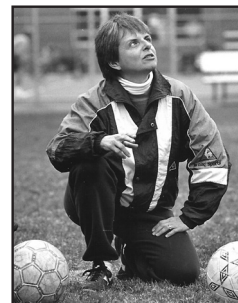
